Unified planning

The Region shall take planning as a method of intervention, defining objectives, criteria and mode of its action, while respecting the principle of subsidiarity, in order to meet the needs of the community and pursue the social and economic development of the territory.

Regional Planning

Regional planning is realized in line with national and European strategies, particularly with the strategy "Europe 2020", which aims at smart, sustainable, inclusive, geared to developing an economy based on knowledge and innovation, more efficient in terms of resources, greener and more competitive economy and a high employment rate, which promotes the social and territorial cohesion.

Europe 2020

In pursuit of the objectives of the "Europe 2020" contribute significantly to the European Structural Funds. Goal of unified planning is to ensure a coordinated action to be undertaken, with a view to developing cross-sector, to be achieved in the medium term, and in an integrated approach that aims to optimize the impact of interventions.

Planning process

The planning process is formalized in documents which explain tasks and tools necessary for the achievement of the results that the region aims. At the programming unit is responsible for:

- Preparation of regional planning documents
 General, in implementation of Law no. 35/2001 and
 in accordance with the process of harmonization of
 accounting pursuant to Legislative Decree. N.
 118/2011 and subsequent amendments, with the
 cooperation and participation of other public and
 stakeholders' economic, social and cultural rights.
- Preparation of the regional contribution to the National Reform Programme, which defines the actions to be taken each year to achieve the objectives of growth, productivity, employment and sustainability outlined in the strategy "Europe 2020".
- Coordination of the process of integrated planning of structural funds and European investment.

Regional planning documents

Programming as a method for the implementation of political and administrative region defined on the basis of the regional law n. 35 of 29 November 2001 "New rules on Programming", the objectives, criteria and procedures of the regional action, while respecting the principles of subsidiarity and cooperation.

Regional Development Programme - PRS

The Regional Development Programme - PRS - art. 8 of Law no. 35/2001 is the act of programming that identifies the basic guidelines of the region and provides the framework and strategies for the development of the regional community.

It is a strategic document and complex that needs to be specified through the Sector Plans..

Contains the information and the tools to govern the 'discontinuity "between the past and the future and addresses the issues most relevant, by identifying salient nodes on which to act for the future of our region.

And 'an instrument of knowledge and strategic definition long-term formulated by the Government with the method of consultation with the various public and private entities, which identifies the main lines of regional economic, social and territorial cohesion.

Sector Plans

Define the specific objectives and instruments as well as planned administrative and regulatory aspects for the realization of works or services by both public and private in a relationship of shared cost and operational public-private partnerships.

Economic and Financial Planning Document - DPEF

DPEF It is an act of address for the business of government in the region, the institutions, companies and regional agencies, for the following year, constituting a moment of synthesis and formulation of corrective actions.

Regional Transport Plan

The Regional Transport Plan has the institutional duty to organize policies pertaining to the field of Infrastructure and Mobility, where it exercises the commitment the region to ensure efficiency, safety and sustainability to the problem of mobility already very high, which in the future is certainly destined to increase, according to all Italian and European estimates.
