#### Constitutional background to the General Assembly

The METREX AISBL Statutes, Section 5, (see the METREX web site at <u>www.eurometrex.org</u>) set out the framework for the General Assembly. Section 5 deals with,

- Article 10. Composition and Representation at the General Assembly
- Article 11. Powers of the General Assembly
- Article 12. Frequency of General Assemblies, Notification, Agenda and Minutes
- Article 13. Decision-making at the General Assembly

Members have to be notified of the General Assembly (GA) and the draft Agenda, by e-mail or fax, one month in advance, as required by Article 12. The Agenda and Agenda Notes are also published on the METREX web site.

The first GA was held at the Nice biennial Conference in 1998, although not within the framework of the present Statutes, which were finally approved by the Managing Committee at the Meeting in Bologna in 1999. Subsequent GA have been held as follows.

- Second GA at the Torino Conference in 2000
- Third GA at the Thessaloniki Conference in 2002
- Fourth GA at the Barcelona Conference in 2004
- Fifth GA at the Szczecin Conference 2006
- Sixth GA in London in 2008
- Seventh in Berlin in 2010
