The joint sustainable development of urban and rural areas for stronger regions is and remains a great opportunity and challenge - especially in times of the climate crisis, coronavirus pandemic, advancing urbanization and dynamic housing markets.

For the first time, the European expert conference URP2020 on sustainable and resilient urban-rural partnerships will take place on 26 – 27 November 2020. Under the patronage of the German Federal Minister for Education and Research (BMBF), Anja Karliczek, representatives from science, politics and practice will exchange approaches and identify future research needs. Exciting keynote speakers will contribute to the conference and you too can also take part. An innovative event app offers information and the possibility to interact even in advance.

The keynote speakers include Maria Vassilakou, who as Vienna's Deputy Mayor oversaw the transition of the city into one of the most livable metropolises in the world, and Prof. Silke Weidner, who was a key-advisor for the renewal of the Leipzig Charter. With over 30 interactive sessions, all of which are organized by international partners, the following topics will receive special attention: governance of successful urban-rural partnerships, regional land-use management, resilience and extreme events, regional circular economy and digitization.
