ABOUT THE SPEAKERS



FRIEDERIKE DETRY is Policy Officer at the Directorate-General for Environment of the European Commission and is responsible for the EMAS scheme. She is involved in the action plan "Greening the Commission", which has the aim to make the European Commission climate-neutral by 2030. Friederike Detry will give an insight into the exact approach of the European Commission to reach this target and will illustrate how public administrations can benefit from this good practice.



DR. KRIS BACHUS is a research manager of climate and sustainable developmen at HIVA, University of Leuven (Belgium). He will outline the sustainable development policy framework in Belgium and Flanders. Drawing from a recent study, Kris Bachus will address spillover effects, the role of local governments, stakeholder participation, monitoring and indicators, mainstreaming and co-ordination challenges.



DR. BRIGITTE DAHLBENDER is the state chairwoman of the BUND Baden-Württemberg and a member of the State Government's Advisory Board for Sustainable Development. She will give an insight into selected aspects of the sustainability strategies of the federal government and the state of Baden-Württemberg, outline the opportunities and challenges for administrations and explain the important role of public sector in the overall context of sustainability.



STEFAN KUHN is Deputy Regional Director for Europe of ICLEI (Local Governments for Sustainability), supervising activities in the areas of urban governance and social innovation, sustainable mobility, cultural transition and social justice in Europe. He has been actively involved in the development of the 2020 Leipzig Charter, the European Green Capital Network, the Intelligent Cities Challenge (ICC) and the European Sustainable Development Network (ESDN).



FRANK GEETS is Administrator-General at the Agency For Facility Operations of the Government of Flanders. Being an Ambassador of sustainability, Frank Geets embedded it as one of the added values for the organisation and developed, together with his board of directors a mission, vision and objective framework with sustainability as the common thread. In 2020 the agency received an SDG-Champion Certificate from UNITAR.



PETER RABAEY is Administrator-General at the HR Agency of the Government of Flanders (AgO). Peter Rabaey, lawyer by education, heads AgO since 2016. Over the past years, AgO grew into a common service provider for HR and has worked on high-quality, efficient and customer-oriented HR services and HR policy. AgO supports 29.000 civil servants and HR-professionals in the fields of HR administration, regulation, selection and wellbeing and develops HR policy.



Since January 2021, **PROF. DR. DIANA PRETZELL** is the Mayor of Environment of Mannheim. She is responsible for environment and climate protection and the implementation of the European Green Deal at local level (Mannheim Message). Previously, Prof. Dr. Pretzell worked as a director of the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) Germany, last as a director for biodiversity policy.
